Children will continue to develop communication and language skills through jocused activities and gree play. Listening and speaking skills will be encouraged through rhymes, stories and conversation during gree play and carpet times.

Math

In. Math. the children will continue to develop counting skills and number recognition through daily focused math sessions using BBC's 'Number Blocks' and the White Rose Maths Program as a tool for learning. The children will explore numbers, number systems and begin to look at calculating numbers through games,

Physical Development

Children will continue to develop gine and gross motor skills through gocused PE sessions (managed by trained PE instructors within the Acorn Academy Trust), and through the use of manipulatives within the classroom environment, aiming to give the children the skills required to eggectively control their body movements in order to develop tricky skills e.g. pencil control.
