Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to Term 5. Just a short newsletter as I've been away with Voyagers but there is lots of news of events taking place this weekend and this term.

News from the classes:

Shooting Stars: This week we have started our new theme it is castles, knights and dragons. We have been learning about materials which are used to make buildings. In Shooting Stars, we think all of our houses are made out of brick, but we have learnt that castles are mostly made from stone and wood. In music we are learning about musical stories; this week we learnt the song 'The teddy bears picnic' and we listened to the music and discussed the different instruments we could hear. We also listened to when the music changed tempo and pitch. In maths this week we have continued to develop our knowledge of teen numbers, building greater understanding that teen numbers all have 10 and then some more and we have been practicing counting very carefully to ensure we have the correct number of objects.

Explorers: Mrs Perrin came back and has been working in Explorers class with us. In maths we have been counting in 2s in Year 1 and In Year 2 we have been multiplying and dividing. In English we had to design a door that a set of old, rusty keys unlocked. Yesterday in Science we found out about the four things animals need to survive, they are shelter, water, food and air. Geography we are finding out about where our food comes from and started by looking at the different shops in Trowbridge. - Luca and Fynn

Discoverers: In English we have started reading Varjak Paw: it is about a cat who goes on an adventure. Year 4s have been learning about decimals this week, finding tenths and hundredths and comparing decimals. Year 3s have been finding unit fractions of an amount such as 1/6 of 18. In science we have started our Forces and Magnets unit. Forces are pushes or pulls and we came up with lots of different examples. Lawson and Brie


