Acorn Education Trust are running a good bank drive to support pupils, their gamilies and the wider local community over the Easter break. Demand gor good banks has increased exponentially over the course of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Trussell Trust, one of the UK's largest good bank charities, reported that in 2020/21 they provided over 2.5 million three-day emergency good supplies and support to people in the UK; with over 980,000 of those supplies going to children.
